


If the factory radio in your car matches the one in the picture below, your vehicle model year is between 2009 and 2011.



Please refer to the "Original Vehicle Wiring Diagram" to connect the corresponding numbered wiring harness:

Connect to the A-end on to, then connect the B-end to the factory male plug.



Connect 2 to 4. If the radio does not power on, connect 3 to 4.

Connect 5 to 7.

Connect 8 to 9.

If the factory radio in your car matches the one in the picture below, your vehicle model year is between 2012 and 2017.



Please refer to the "Original Vehicle Wiring Diagram" to connect the corresponding numbered wiring harness:


Connect to the factory male plug.

Connect 2 to 4. if the radio does not power on, connect 3 to 4.


Connect 5 to 6.

If your car has steering wheel control buttons and to avoid any issues with them not functioning properly, follow these steps:


For vehicle models between 2009 and 2011, please enter Settings -- Factory (input"3368") -- Car Model, and select "RZC (Raise)-- Ford -- Fiesta -- 2009-2012.Mid."




For vehicle models between 2012 and 2017, please enter Settings--Factory (input"3368")--Car Model, and select "RZC (Raise)--Ford--Fiesta--2013-2014.Mid."



After that, open the SWC app and manually map the steering wheel control (SWC) keys as shown in the image.
